Family Promise Needs Your Help!

Family Promise of Greater Denver enables communities of faith, like St Philip, to assist families experiencing homelessness. Each host congregation furnishes clean, safe, and private accommodations as well as a hospitality room where guests can relax, socialize, and catch up with personal tasks.

Guests arrive at St Philip at 5:30pm, have dinner at 6pm, and remain overnight. In the morning guests return to the day site, leaving St Philip at 7am via a Family Promise van.

St Philip becomes the temporary home for these families for one week. In our supportive environment, they can maintain their dignity and self-esteem. The kindness and consideration of our St Philip volunteers can help alleviate the hurt and alienation of homelessness.

Beginning this **Sunday, July 21 though Saturday, July 27**, St Philip will host 4 families, 7 adults and 7 children. We need approximately 75 volunteers during a host week. And as always, members of St Philip have been generous with sharing their donations, time and talent.

We are still in need of some volunteers to fill our Overnight Hosts shifts, Van Drivers, and Meal Hosts.
