#### **Endowment Committee Meeting Results**

The Endowment Committee met in May to review the endowment requests. The following endowments were approved:

- Sharing with Sheridan, for the purpose of securing additional food supplies and equipment as needed \$1,500
- Seeds of South Sudan, to house, feed and provide school materials for the students who are quarantined in the school dormitories \$1,000

The committee will meet again in the fall to consider additional grants and reassess the needs of our church community. We will also re-examine the financial position of the endowment fund at that time.

You can also bring items to church anytime. If the church is not open, just leave them beside the church office door at the end of the courtyard; someone is checking on a regular basis. If you are unable to drop off at either location, contact Jan Philpy and she can arrange for someone to pick up your donation at your home.
