Dear Fellow Members of St. Philip,

At the resumption of our special meeting to consider the recommendation of the Call Committee to call Pastor Brad Doty as Senior Pastor of St. Philip Lutheran Church, I reported that 506 ballots were mailed to confirmed members of St. Philip. 384 ballots were returned and counted by members of the Council. There were 310 yes votes and 74 no votes. The yes votes represented 80.7% of the total votes cast and satisfied the minimum 2/3 requirement to approve the call of Pastor Doty to be Senior Pastor of St. Philip.

After the report of the vote to call Pastor Doty, Pastor Brad replied that he accepted the call to be Senior Pastor of St. Philip. The results of the vote to call Pastor Doty and his acceptance are being forwarded to the Rocky Mountain Synod.

The date for the installation of Pastor Doty as Senior Pastor of St. Philip will be communicated to all as soon as that date is selected.

Thanks to all who participated is this important decision for St. Philip Lutheran Church.
