You can also bring items to church anytime. If the church is not open, just leave them beside the church office door at the end of the courtyard; someone is checking on a regular basis. If you are unable to drop off at either location, contact Jan Philpy and she can arrange for someone to pick up your donation at your home.

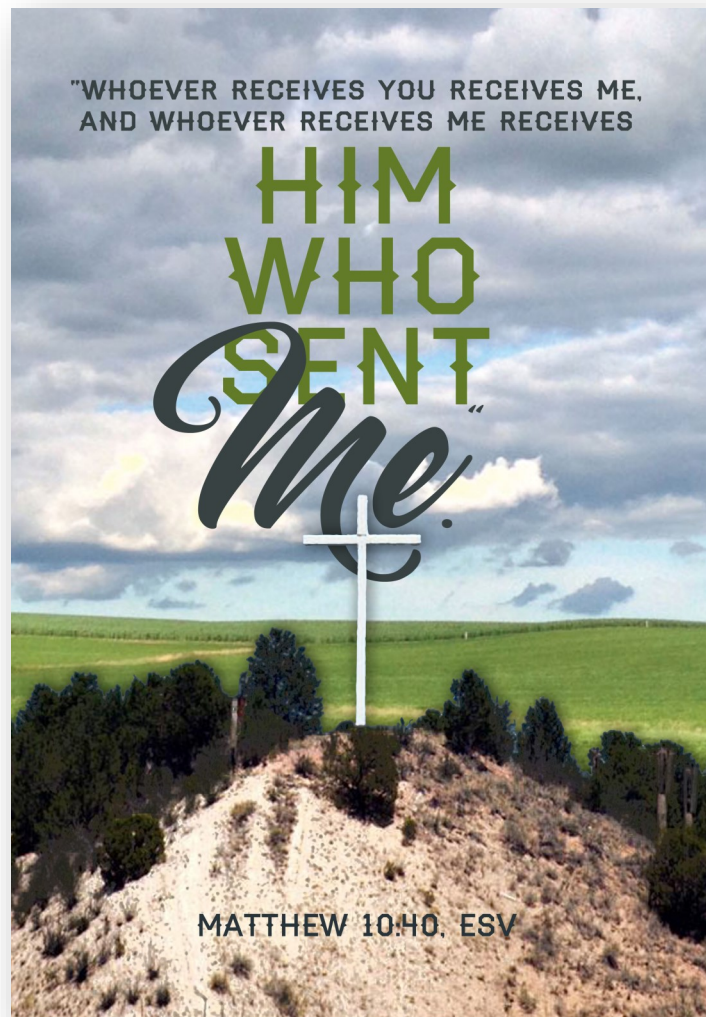
We need volunteers! High school students and above are encouraged—hours are flexible on Thursdays. Contact Carole Kessler for details.
