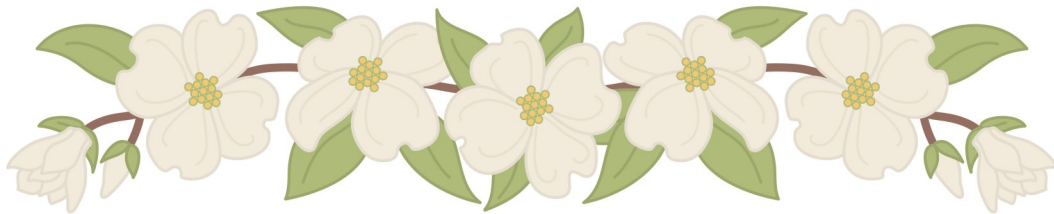
Sharing with Sheridan Food Pantry
