#### Getting Excited: 2021 Stewardship Appeal

In the next couple of days, you will be receiving a stewardship packet in the mail. We hope you will take some time to look at the materials in this packet and get excited with us about what is to come in 2021, at St. Philip Lutheran Church. Stewardship Sunday is **October 18**, and we invite you to bring your Statement of Intent card. Or you can mail it to St. Philip. If you have never made in a Statement of Intent or financial commitment before and want more information about it, Pastor Brad (bdoty@stphilip-co.org) is happy to talk to you about it. #### **Cares Act Provisions**

Many of us have been financially blessed through this pandemic and have been fortunate enough to be able to save some money or reduce our expenses. If you would like to donate a portion of those blessings to St. Philip Lutheran Church, there are a couple of tax benefits that could be gained through the CARES Act Provisions for charitable contributions. Please see the article below.

#### **CARES Act Provisions**

We would like to make you aware of two provisions included in the CARES Act that impact charitable giving:

- 1. For 2020, individuals can deduct up to \$300 of charitable donations, even if they do not itemize their deductions. Normally, an individual has to itemize deductions in order to deduct charitable donations.
- 2. For 2020, individuals can deduct up to 100% of their adjusted gross income (AGI). Normally, the limit is 60%.

The second point would be of particular interest to people who have a large amount of assets/money, but not much annual income. Like retired people, for example. Assume a retired individual has \$30,000 of AGI, because they are no longer working full time. But assume this individual has a large sum of money in the bank that accumulated while they were working. Prior to 2020, they would only be able to deduct \$18,000 per year (AGI times 60%). But in 2020, they could deduct up to \$30,000 (AGI times 100%).

We are not recommending any tax advice. However, we do want to make you generally aware of new provisions from the CARES Act and recommend that you seek guidance from your tax advisor.

#### <u>In-Person Prayer Group</u>

Our in-person prayer group will resume on Tuesdays at 2pm. All safety protocols will be followed, meaning that you must sign in, you must take your temp, and you must wear your mask. We will meet in a room that accommodates our numbers. Our first prayer time is next **Tuesday, October 13**. All are welcome!

#### Mission Endowment Fund Grant Applications

Grant applications will be accepted **October 1-31.** Application forms are available in the office or online through the St. Philip website. Members of St. Philip may make a

mission grant request for projects or activities that have a specific purpose and intended measurable result or impact. The grant requests cannot be used for church operating expenses or programs that are normally funded by the St. Philip Lutheran Church budget. All applications will be reviewed in November and applicants will be contacted following the review process.

Get your costumes ready and join us on **Friday, October 30 from 5:30-7pm** for the 10th Annual St. Philip Lutheran Church Family Halloween Party, Trunk-or-Treat style!
