Church News

Reopening Task Force

The Re-Opening Task Force has decided to move worship into the Sanctuary starting **Sunday, November 1!** (This is also the day Daylight Savings Time ends.) Both services will be held in the Sanctuary starting on this day. Between now and then, we will continue to prioritize outdoor worship, which means we could move inside if the weather is not good.

We will be allowing 20 family units into the Sanctuary for worship. Each service will have a section of pews to sit in, which allows two pews in between each family unit. The pews are color coded and we will have each services sit in a different colored pew. We will also be sanitizing after each service. We will be asking people to register for worship so we do not go over our numbers. Any overflow attendees will be able to worship in the narthex. We will have the ushers check people in and take everyone's temperature. Communion and offering will be done the same way we have been doing it outside.

Another change that has already started is that the congregation is able to speak the responses, the creed, the Lord's Prayer, etc. At this time, we continue to ask the congregation not to sing.

We will continue to livestream the 9:00am service and post the recording on our website.
