### **Coming Back Together Again - In Person!**

**With CAUTION and CARE the Re-Opening Task Force has decided to begin in-person worship and ministry meetings/events again. We will continue to follow our COVID-19 guidelines and precautions. Mask are required for worship and all meetings and events.**

Even though the COVID-19 case numbers continue to go down, this is not the time to let down our guard. We still need to be diligent in wearing masks, properly, and socially distance.

In-person worship will resume on **Sunday, January 31** with two worship services, 9:00am and 10:30am. The 9:00am worship will continue to be live-streamed online, on Zoom.

Ministry meetings and events can resume immediately.

### **Register for In-Person Worship**

We ask that you register your family for worship. This way we do not go over our occupancy to ensure we are able to safely distance ourselves throughout the sanctuary. Anyone who does not sign up for worship will be able to worship in the narthex if the sanctuary is full. We will have the ushers check people in and take everyone's temperature. Communion will continue with individual packets, and there will be an offering plate in the sanctuary as well as the opportunity to give electronically. Items we need:

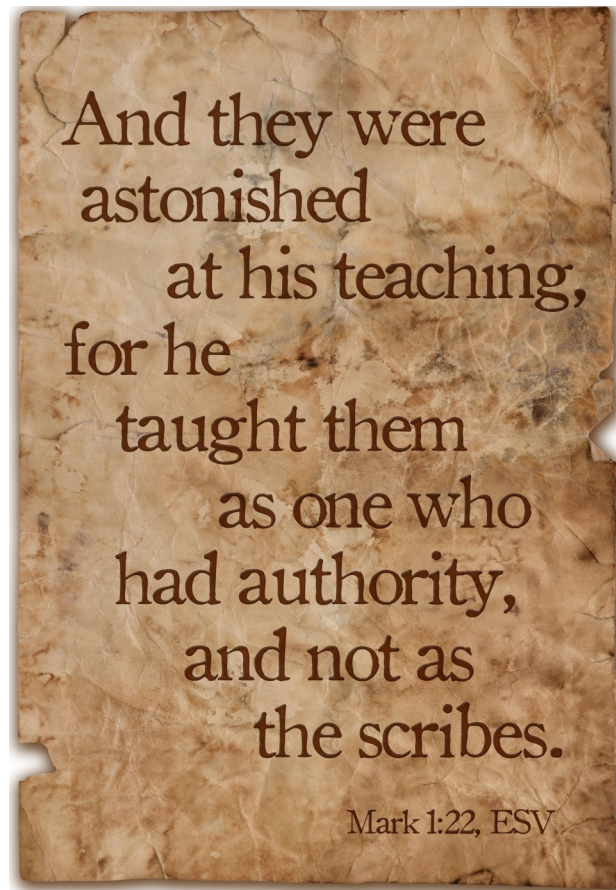
- Canned black beans
