Lenten Focus: A Walk Through Holy Week

Holy Week in the Christian Church is the holiest week of the year as we walk with Jesus to the cross and experience his resurrection on Easter. All of these events occur in one week as we process with Jesus on Palm Sunday, receive communion on Maundy Thursday, mourn Jesus death on Good Friday, have hope on Easter Vigil, and celebrate Jesus resurrection on Easter.

This year during the season of Lent at St. Philip, we will have the opportunity to walk through Holy Week together on Sunday mornings. Instead of putting all of these events in one week, we are spreading them out throughout the season of Lent to truly focus on each day and all of the events that occur on these holy days. Starting on February 21, the first Sunday in Lent, we will begin to walk through Holy Week together:

Wednesday, **February 17** – Ash Wednesday (6:30pm)

Sunday, February 21 – Palm Sunday

Sunday, February 28 – Maundy Thursday – Passover/Lord's Supper

Sunday, March 7 – Maundy Thursday – Foot Washing/Service

Sunday, March 14 – Maundy Thursday – Garden/Betrayal

Sunday, March 21 – Good Friday

Sunday, March 28 – Easter Vigil/Prayer Vigil

Sunday, April 4 - Easter

In February of last year, 18 high school graduates traveled to South Sudan to serve as volunteer teachers and learn about their homeland and culture. Instead of returning last June to Kenya as planned, our students have been sheltering from COVID, flooding and other disasters for 11 months, while continuing to support their communities. Four other high school graduates had gone to South Sudan in 2017 to work and have not been able to find jobs. For their safety, it is now time to bring all 22 students back to Nakuru, Kenya. The cost will be about \$13,000 which includes travel, medical exams, new clothes, and other expenses.
