### Lenten Focus: A Walk Through Holy Week

Holy Week in the Christian Church is the holiest week of the year as we walk with Jesus to the cross and experience his resurrection on Easter. All of these events occur in one week as we process with Jesus on Palm Sunday, receive communion on Maundy Thursday, mourn Jesus death on Good Friday, have hope on Easter Vigil, and celebrate Jesus resurrection on Easter.

This year during the season of Lent at St. Philip, we will have the opportunity to walk through Holy Week together on Sunday mornings. **Instead of putting all of these events in one week, we are spreading them out throughout the season of Lent to truly focus on each day and all of the events that occur on these holy days.** Starting on February 21, the first Sunday in Lent, we will begin to walk through Holy Week together:

**Wednesday, February 17** – Ash Wednesday (6:30pm)

**Sunday, February 21** – Palm Sunday

**Sunday, February 28** – Maundy Thursday – Passover/Lord's Supper

**Sunday, March 7** – Maundy Thursday – Foot Washing/Service

**Sunday, March 14** – Maundy Thursday – Garden/Betrayal

**Sunday, March 21** – Good Friday

**Sunday, March 28** – Easter Vigil/Prayer Vigil

**Sunday, April 4** - Easter
