Presenting a Musical Masterpiece for Ascension Day

To celebrate **Ascension Day, Sunday, May 16**, our organist Bryan Chuan will be playing one of the great masterpieces of 20th century organ literature, *L'Ascension*, Four Symphonic Meditations for Organ, by Olivier Messiaen (1908-1992) **at the 9am service**. Every composition by Olivier Messiaen is inspired by his radical devotion to the Christian faith and *L'Ascension* covers a wide range of spiritual emotions, ranging from timeless meditation to ecstatic joy.
