This week's prelude and postlude features **Spiritual Suite for Piano by Margaret Bonds** (1913-1972), which contains arrangements of the spirituals *Dem Bones*, *Peter Go Ring Dem Bells*, and *Wade in the Water*. One of the first Black composers and performers to gain recognition in the United States, Bonds is best remembered today for her popular arrangements of African-American spirituals and frequent collaborations with Langston Hughes. Her piano works synthesize diverse musical idioms that delight both pianists and audiences.
