## Worship Information

### New Service Time!

**We have permanently moved to one service at 9am.** Online worship will still be available. We are also offering communion at the railing again. You are still welcome to pick up an individual communion packet and take communion at your seat during distribution if you feel more comfortable that way.

**FYI**, registration is no longer required to attend our services. Masks are no longer required, unless you are not vaccinated. If you feel more comfortable attending with a mask, please feel free to do so. If you want to sit socially distanced in the sanctuary, you can sit on the west side in every other pew.

### Prelude and Postlude Series

For the next four services, our organist Bryan Chuan will feature music by American composers in anticipation of July 4th coinciding with Sunday. This week's prelude and postlude features music by composers from the "Boston Six" - a group of composers from the early 19th century and 20th century that brought legitimacy to American music in the Western musical canon. Amy Beach (1867-1944) is the best known of the "Boston Six," and her notable works include the Gaelic Symphony and numerous chamber and vocal works. Prelude on an Old Folk Tune is her best known organ work, and it features sumptuous late romantic counterpoint and harmony. Arthur Foote was a prominent organist in New England, and his works were influenced by Brahms and Wagner. The Sortie in C major is part of a larger group of 7 works for organ widely performed in its time but rather obscure today.
