# Worship Changes Due to the Delta Variant

It has been wonderful to have restrictions loosened this summer as the spread of COVID-19 lessened and vaccinations became readily available. The Delta variant has certainly complicated things as it is showing to be highly transmissible and even vaccinated people are both contracting and transmitting this COVID variant.

For this reason, we are asking that you social distance and wear a mask again in the Sanctuary for worship. We also ask that you wear a mask when coming to the church during the week, until you enter into the room you are meeting in. Since we are an Early Learning Center, we are required to have masks on around children. When you are meeting, the group can decide whether they are comfortable wearing a mask or not.

This is a hard decision and while we would prefer to not wear a mask, we have to protect our children who are unable to be vaccinated and those who are vulnerable, even after receiving the vaccine. We do so out of love for our children, the vulnerable and our neighbor.

#### Notes from the Organist

This week's prelude and postlude will feature the first of Felix Mendelssohn's six organ sonatas, a landmark in the organ repertoire. Mendelssohn resurrected the role of the organ as a concert instrument, showcasing his formidable pedal technique and contrasting organ stops. His sonatas do not follow the classical sonata form but rather are influenced by the counterpoint of J.S. Bach and the symphonic narrative of late Beethoven. The first organ sonata contrasts stern counterpoint with heavenly chorales before culminating in a triumphant theme not unlike Ode to Joy. Think of each sonata as a sermon as you enjoy the music.
