Another student, Mamer Bior Aleer, will complete law school in 2023 and St. Philip assisted in launching him on his career. The 2019 Girls Leadership Seminar was a hugely successful day supported by the St. Philip Endowment Fund. In July 2022, Sue and Pastor Heidi McGinness will lead the second day-long event in Nakuru, Kenya. As Kenya comes out of COVID restrictions, 2022 brings significant challenges. Sue will provide an update and opportunities to walk alongside the ministry of SOSS, which formed over 11 years ago in response to former lost boy, Arok Garang and his vision to nurture and educate refugee children to be leaders in South Sudan.


