St. Philip Mission Endowment Fund Committee

On May 4, the Endowment Fund Committee met to review all grant applications that were submitted by April 30, 2022. The following applications were received and approved as follows:

- Seeds of Sudan submitted by Sue Counterman, requesting \$1,000 to help fund the Girls' Leadership Seminar in July. Committee awarded \$1,000.
- St. Philip's Women's Ministry submitted by Erin White, requesting \$1,700 to cover the costs for event including fee for guest speaker, refreshments, journals for attendees, flowers and misc. expense. Committee awarded \$1,700.
- St. Philip Property Team submitted by Jerry Mydlach, requesting \$2,500 to help in covering the cost of re-siding the Early Learning Center. Estimated cost of materials is \$6,500. Committee awarded \$2,500.
- St Philip Children's Ministry submitted by Melinda Svenkerud, requesting \$1,500 to pay towards major expense of fee (\$2,800) for Rainbow Trail counselors for Vacation Bible School with the hope that all children wishing to participate may do so without paying a registration fee. Committee awarded \$3,000.
