2022 ANNUAL REPORT

STATISTICS

During 2022, we served 5,663 families (17,906 individuals). The average number of families is nearly identical from 2021 (110) to 2022 (111), but the average family size has declined by nearly one quarter, from 4.13 people per family in 2021 to 3.16 in 2022.

LINK-2-FEED

We have implemented Link-2-Feed, a Food Bank of the Rockies internet system for registration. Registrants receive a card which they can use every time they come, thus speeding up distribution on Thursdays. Thanks to the Sheridan School System for their help with this.

TRAILER UPDATE

SwS distributes in all sorts of weather. To help in the heat of summer, one of our trailers is now equipped to refrigerate food until we distribute it.

VOLUNTEERS!!

SwS has so many wonderful volunteers, and distribution could not happen without them! All involved with the pantry are so grateful for their dedication. Two groups involved are Columbine Kiwanis and the helpers from Concordia on the Lake. The Kiwanis volunteers are present every week to help prepare and pass out food, and the Concordia people come monthly to repackage large quantity items.

COMMUNITY

SwS continues to be part of Sheridan, participating in community and school activities, assisting with food for various youth camps and programs, and sharing our gear. We also are represented in CANDO, a visioning and planning group for the Sheridan community.

FINANCES

Since operations began in 2014, Sharing with Sheridan Food Pantry has been financially sound, partly because we are an all-volunteer group and primarily due to the generosity of people like you in providing time, talent, and donations of money and supplies.
