


Second Reading Revelation 1:4-8

God, who is rich in mercy and love, gives us a new birth into a living hope through the sacrament of baptism. By water and the Word God delivers us from sin and death and raises us to new life in Jesus Christ. We are united with all the baptized in the one body of Christ, anointed with the gift of the Holy Spirit, and joined in God's mission for the life of the world.

P: Who presents Moira for baptism?

Sponsors: We present Moira Grace McCammon for baptism.

P: Kristen and Jason, called by the Holy Spirit, trusting in the grace and love of God, do you desire to have Moira baptized into Christ?

Parents: I do.

As you bring your child to receive the gift of baptism, you are entrusted with responsibilities: to live with her among God's faithful people, to bring her to the word of God and the holy supper, to teach her the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and the Ten Commandments, to place in her hands the holy scriptures,
