PLANTED IN FAITH

St. Philip is a church that values our faith and being grounded in God's Word. We are rooted in Christ, and our unity comes from our shared faith in Jesus.

Just as preparing a garden requires tilling the soil and adding nutrients, preparing our hearts requires laying a strong foundation of faith. We do this by reading Scripture, learning the stories of the Bible, and growing in our knowledge of God and Jesus Christ.



In recent years, opportunities for Bible study at St. Philip have grown, giving everyone the chance to join a study that fits their schedule. This reflects how deeply we value gathering to read, study, discuss, and learn together.

We are also committed to continuing Vacation Bible School as a free offering for all children, because we believe every child should have the chance to come, learn, and experience the love of God.



GROWING IN GRACE

St. Philip is a church that comes together to grow in relationships and to live in community, even amid our differences. We don't all think the same, nor do we share the same political or social values; yet we are united in our faith in Jesus Christ.

As we gather, we create space to listen, learn, support, love, and walk alongside one another. Our differing perspectives don't divide us, but instead enrich the community we share for the sake of each other.

In this kind of community, we grow in grace and experience more deeply the love and grace of God. It is this community that God calls us to live as we welcome, love and grow together.



Giving in Love

St. Philip is a church that gives from the heart—for the sake of others and for the glory of God. Whether through our time, talents, or financial resources, we give in love: to those who are hungry, those in need, those who are suffering, those who are lonely, and to the church and the work God is doing through St. Philip.

God has blessed us—both as individuals and as a church—and in response to those blessings, we joyfully give back to God. At St. Philip, this happens in many ways. We provide opportunities for people to serve, to share their gifts, and to support the mission and ministry of the church.



As people of God, we financially give to the church as an act of worship and gratitude, to support the mission of sharing God's love, to care for others, and to grow in faith by trusting God with our resources. In gratitude to God, we give back to God by giving to the church. This practice is known as tithing.
