
Chrismon Devotion






The Crown is a symbol for the Kingship of Jesus Christ, the King of kings and Lord of lords (I Timothy 6:15).







This became clear when Jesus was arrested and put on trial. Jesus answers Pilate, "You say that I am a king. For this I was born, and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice" (John 18:36-37).

We have come to understand what Jesus meant and that his kingship is spiritual and

heavenly. For Jesus's death and resurrection was actually his victory over sin and death. His place of honor is now at the right hand of God (I Corinthians 15:54) and Jesus has become king as he reigns over heaven and earth. Jesus can also be our king if we let Him reign in our hearts and in our lives.
