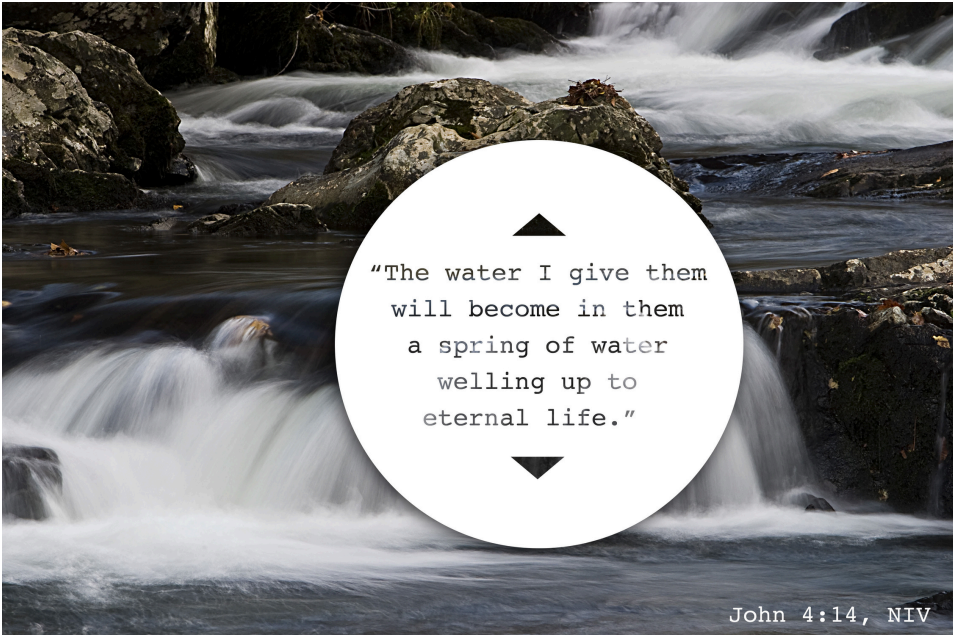

### Augustana Homes Celebration

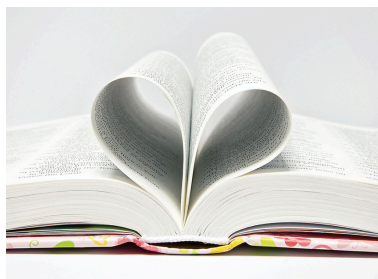

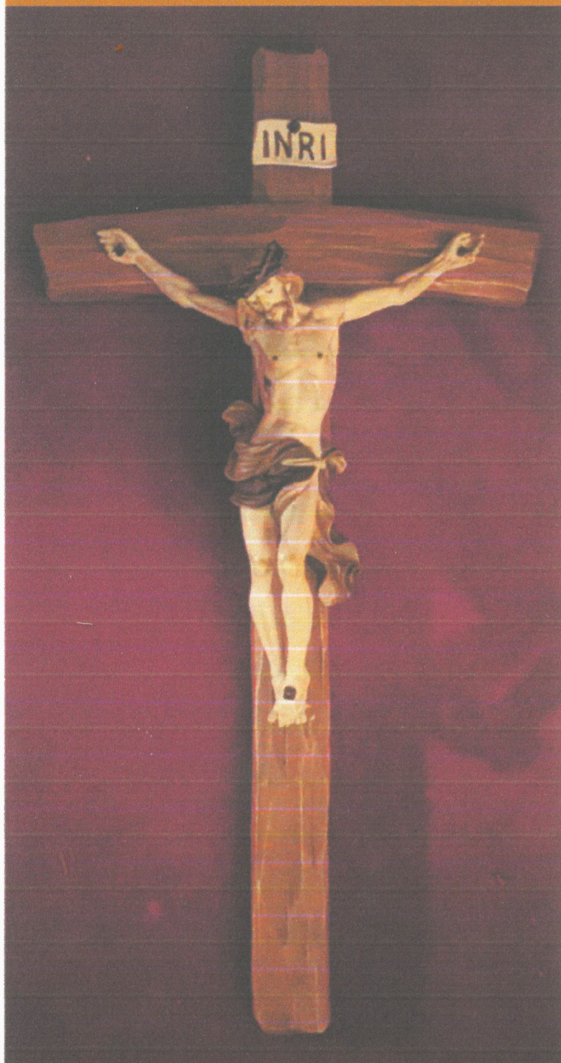


## Men's Group - Pizza Night

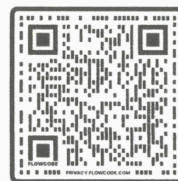
