## Altar Flowers

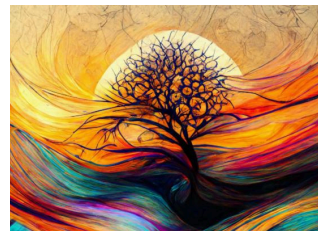
**Altar flowers for this coming Sunday have been given by Michael & Sandi Stevermer in celebration of Jesus' Resurrection!**

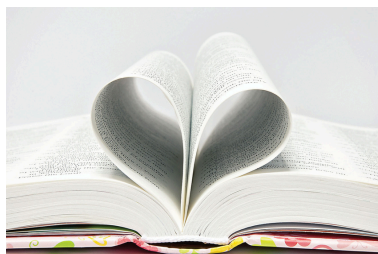
