Greeters Ministry

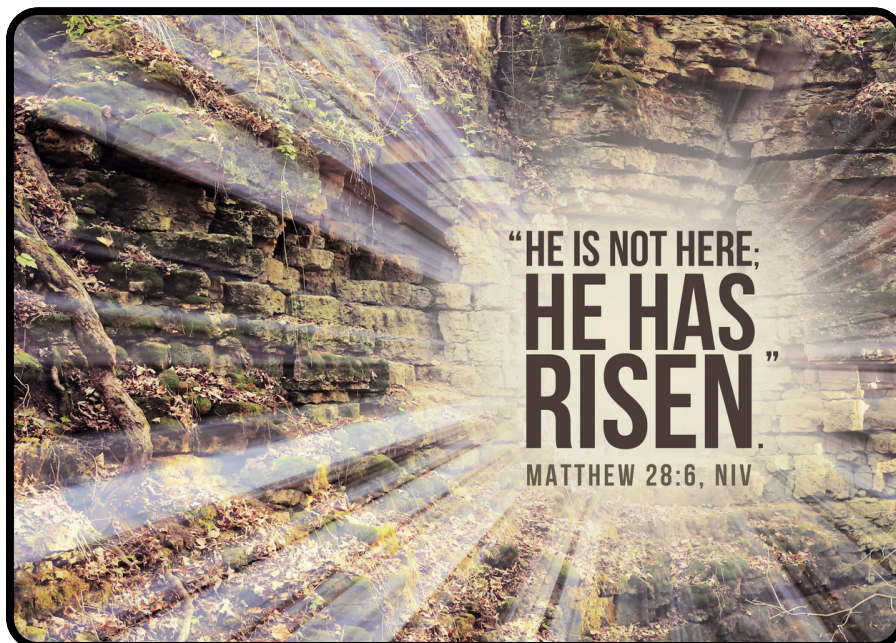

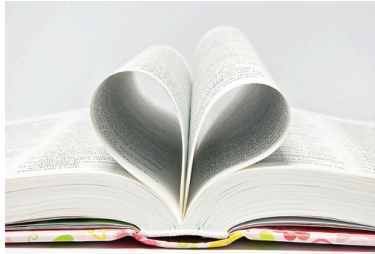
